The Office of the Solicitor General (OSG), through the FY 2019 GAA, R.A. 11260, intends to apply the sum of Nine Million Four Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand Pesos (₱9,483,000.∞) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment for the:

The OSG now invites bids for the annual procurement of eighteen (18 ordinary security guards and two (2) officers-in-charge (OIC), for a total of twenty (20) licensed, trained and uniformed security guards, to perform twelve (12) hours security services per shift daily including Sundays and Holidays to adequately guard and protect OSG's properties, premises, personnel and clients at the Office of the Solicitor General and its extension offices and parking areas. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

Bidders should have completed, within two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II, Instruction to Bidders.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Bidding is restricted to wholly-owned Filipino private security agency, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws and regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the **Administrative Division 2nd FIr., OSG Bldg., 134 Amorsolo St., Legaspi Village, Makati City** on or before 2:25 p.m. of 21 October 2019. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 18. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address above. Late bids shall not be accepted.

A complete set of bidding documents may be acquired by interested bidders from the OSG on 3 October 2019 between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. until 12:00 noon of 21 October 2019, Monday to Friday, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount stated above, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB.

The OSG reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
