### INVITATION TO BID

(RE-BIDDING)

#### ONE (1) YEAR HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION (HMO) PROGRAM FOR ALL OFFICIAL AND EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE OF THE SOLICITOR GENERAL

The **Office of the Solicitor General (OSG)**, through the FY 2020 Automatic Appropriation Special Account in the General Fund 152 (SAGF-152) authorized under Special Provision No. 1 – Income from Collections of the Office of the Solicitor General pursuant to RA 9417, otherwise known as the OSG Reform Law, intends to apply the sum of **Six Million Pesos (P6,000,000.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment for the:

The OSG now invites bids for the re-bidding of one (1) year health maintenance organization (HMO) program for all official and employees of the OSG. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

Bidders should have completed, within two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II, Instruction to Bidders.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens, sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to R.A. No. 5183.

Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the **Administrative Division 2<sup>nd</sup> Flr., OSG Bldg., 134 Amorsolo St., Legaspi Village, Makati City** on or before **1:25 p.m. of 12 October 2020**. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend at the address above. Late bids shall not be accepted.

A complete set of bidding documents may be acquired by interested bidders from the OSG on 23 September 2020 between 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. until 12:00 noon of **12 October 2020**, Monday to Friday, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount stated above, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB.

The OSG reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
