TERMS OF REFERENCE

Project: PURCHASE, DELIVERY, DISMANTLING, AND

INSTALLATION OF LUMANAIRE LIGHTNING FIXTURES AT

EXTENSION OFFICES LOCATED AT APMC AND

MONTEPINO BUILDINGS

I. RATIONALE

The modernization of lighting fixtures is in-line with the government green project procurement of goods, government agencies shall be able to incorporate the minimum energy performance standards for equipment, product, and devices in crafting technical specifications. The OSG's existing luminaire diffuser type lighting fixtures using fluorescent tube is no longer responsive to the needs of the current workplace, and it uses more energy than a luminaire recessed type lighting fixtures using a Light Emitting Diode (LED) lights. The modernization of lighting fixtures will result in substantial energy cost savings that will benefit the OSG.

II. QUALIFICATION OF THE CONTRACTOR

- 1. The Contractor must be legally registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and must possess distributorship of a globally recognized LED tube light.
- 2. The Contractor shall have been in the business of delivering and installing of lighting fixtures for at least three (3) years.
- 3. The Contractor must present a Client Satisfaction Certificate from at least three (3) government agencies or private corporations, with whom the contractor has served within the last five (5) years.

III. DELIVERY SCHEDULE

The acquisition and installation of new luminaire recessed / surfaced type of lighting fixtures for the OSG extension at the APMC Building and Montepino Building shall be completed within sixty (60) working days after office hours only, holidays, Saturdays and Sundays, to complete the scope of works and will commence upon the receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP), which shall include the period of time required in dismantling and installation of the new luminaire recessed / surfaced type lighting fixtures. The delivery of new lighting fixtures is subject to scheduling of the work as determined by the Administrative Division's representative.

IV. SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. The Contractor shall provide all materials, labor, equipment and tools for the dismantling of the existing luminaire diffuser type lighting fixtures and installation of new luminaire recessed type lighting fixtures at the OSG extension offices at APMC Building and Montepino Building.
- 2. The materials to be used for the supply of labor and materials for the dismantling of the existing luminaire diffuser type lighting fixtures and installation of new luminaire recessed type lighting fixtures are of good quality and subject for

inspection by the OSG in-house electrician.

- 3. The Contractor shall dismantle **305 sets** of existing luminaire diffuser type lighting fixtures located at the different divisions/offices at the APMC Building and Montepino Building.
- 4. The Contractor shall provide all wiring components, electrical insulations and all supports needed for the installation of the new lighting fixtures.
- 5. The Contractor shall install **305 sets** of new luminaire lighting fixtures as follows:

VIL CLEAN UP WORKS

Cleaning of the whole area daily from accumulated refuse or debris caused by the work. Upon completion of the project, the entire installation shall be made clean to the satisfaction of the OSG.

VIII. WARRANTIES OF THE CONTRACTOR

1. To guarantee the performance by the winning bidder of its obligations under the contract, it shall post a performance security prior to the signing of the contract. The performance security shall be in an amount not less than the required percentage of the total contract price in any of the following forms and in accordance with the following schedule:

2. The OSG shall pay the CONTRACTOR in accordance with the following schemes/schedules:

Fourth release	5% warranty deposit of the Total Contract Price	For the procurement of Goods, in order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the supplier, a warranty security shall be required from the contract awardee for a minimum period of three (3) months, in the case of Expendable Supplies, or a minimum period of one (1) year, in the case of non-expendable Supplies, after acceptance by the Procuring Entity of the delivered supplies

- 1. The Contractor shall replace defective components parts/accessories of the same or better brand, features and quality if it is not resolved within the allowable resolution time, at no additional cost to the OSG, within the warranty period.
- 2. The Contractor warrants that it shall conform strictly to the terms and conditions of the Terms of Reference.
- 3. The Contractor, in the performance of its services, shall secure, maintain at its own expense all registration, licenses or permits required by National or Local Laws and shall comply with the rules, regulations and directives Regulatory Authorities and Commissions. The contractor undertakes to pay all fees or charges payable to any instrumentality of government or to any other duly constituted authority relating to the use or operation of the installation.
- 4. The Contractor's personnel shall take all necessary precautions for the safety of all persons and properties at or near their area of work and shall comply with all the standard and established safety regulations, rules and practices.
- 5. The Contractor shall coordinate with authorized and/or designated OSG personnel in the performance of their jobs.
- 6. The Contractor shall be liable for loss, damage, or injury as may be due directly through the fault or negligence of its personnel. It shall assume responsibility thereof and the OSG shall be specifically released from any responsibility arising therefrom.
- 7. The Contractor warrants that the installed lighting fixtures are brand new and free from all defects and workmanship guaranteed for two (2) years from the date of completion/acceptance. Any defects or damages which develop within the two (2) year warranty period shall be corrected to the satisfaction of the OSG at no additional cost. The Contractor shall submit Warranty Certificate upon turnover of the project as proof that the installed lighting fixtures are free from defects against workmanship.
- 8. The Contractor shall be allowed 15% of the total contract price as mobilization fee of the total contract price upon commencement of the project. The payment shall be subject to the required Expanded Withholding Tax (EWT) of two percent (1%) and Final Withholding Tax on VAT of five percent (5%).
- 9. Each payment shall be made within fifteen (15) days from submission of Inspection and Acceptance Report issued by the Inspection and Acceptance Committee (IAC) and the Certificate of Completion and Acceptance issued by the Administrative Division and all other required documents based on existing OSG issuances.
