TERMS OF REFERENCE

Supply and Delivery of Online Philippine Legal Database Research Tool

Background:

To successfully defend the Philippine government, its agencies, and its officials in court, lawyers of OSG need quick access to up-to-date and accurate legal information about Philippine law online.

Objective:

The primary aim of this procurement initiative is to provide the lawyers of OSG with a legal research tool on the web containing a wide range of databases pertaining to Philippine law-related materials (Laws, legal issuances, and jurisprudence).

Terms:

- 1. *Scope.* Supply and delivery of Online Philippine Legal Database Research Tool.
- 2. *ABC.* The Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **One million three hundred thousand pesos** (₱ **1,300,000.00**), inclusive of all government taxes, charges, and other standard fees.

- 3. Payment. The supplier shall be paid in full, subject to deduction of applicable taxes, upon the issuance by the OSG of the corresponding Certificate of Acceptance. All bid prices shall be considered as fixed prices, and therefore not subject to price escalation during contract implementation.
- 4. Delivery. Delivery shall be within three (3) days upon receipt of the Purchase Order with the list of users. Delay in delivery shall be subject to penalty equivalent to 1/10 of 1% of the cost of undelivered item/s for every day of delay.

5. Qualifications of the Supplier:

a. The Bidder must have a similar Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's Consumer Price Index, must be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC, completed within 5 years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.

For this purpose, a similar contract shall refer to procurement contract of Online Philippine Law Related Database Research Tool.

- b. The bidder must present a Client Satisfactory Rating from at least five procurement contracts with government agencies and/or private companies with whom the contractor has a past or ongoing contract similar to this project.
- c. The bidder must be the developer or an authorized reseller/dealer or an agent if the reseller/dealer. A current Authorization or reseller certificate or a certificate/agreement/contract of dealership/distributorship, as applicable, from the Manufacturer or Vendor is required as part of the technical component of the bid proposal.
- d. The Bidder must be an Authorized Service Partner (ASP) of the brand being offered. A current valid manufacturer certificate is required as part of the technical component of the bid proposal.
- e. The Bidder must issue a Warranty Certificate that the service shall be available 99% of the contract duration.
- f. The bidder must have a main office or satellite office in or around Metro Manila and/or nearby provinces.
- g. The bidder shall submit documents relevant to the project, such as but not limited to the following:

- Valid DTI or SEC Registration;
- Valid and Current Mayor's Permit/Municipal License;
- Valid and Current Business Permit;
- Tax Clearance Certificate as finally reviewed and approved by BIR;
- Statement of contracts completed which are similar in nature to the contract to be bid.
- h. Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) Computation
- 6. Applicable provisions of the Government Procurement Reform Act (RA No. 9184) and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) shall form part of the Terms of Reference.
